

Raymore-Peculiar School District Spectator/Fan Guidelines—Fall 2020

The Raymore-Peculiar School District has developed the following guidelines and restrictions in an effort to keep our students, coaches, officials and guests safe and healthy at our sporting events, as well as remain consistent with the expectations we have during regular school hours.

**These guidelines may change based on updated CDC, Cass County Health Department, MSHSAA and/or Suburban Conference recommendations.

Expectations for ALL Home Events

- 1. Masks are required to be worn at all times (coaches, staff, guests, and spectators)
- 2. Social distancing of 6 feet is REQUIRED for each individual spectator taped locations show where to sit (1 person per marked seat) Stadium and Gyms
- 3. No concession stands unopened, screw-top type water bottles permitted only

Home Events

Varsity Football Games

- 1. Visitors 2 tickets per MSHSAA game rostered student
- 2. Home 4 tickets per MSHSAA game rostered student (Football limited to 60 rostered per Conference recommendation)
- 3. Cheer 4 tickets per cheerleader
- 4. Dance 4 Tickets per SENIOR Prowler member
- 5. Band 4 tickets per SENIOR band member
- 6. SENIOR Student Section No more than 100 (random drawing more details to follow)

Soccer/8th/9th/JV Football

- 1. Masks Mandatory and Social Distance
- 2. Social distancing of 6 feet is REQUIRED for each individual spectator taped location shows where to sit

Volleyball

- 1. Visitors 2 tickets per MSHSAA game rostered student (All Levels)
- 2. Home 4 tickets per JV & Varsity game rosters
- 3. C-team 2 tickets per MSHSAA game rostered student
- 4. NO STUDENT SECTION

Softball/Swim

Bleachers removed - masks mandatory, social distancing (guests can bring lawn chairs or stand

Golf/Cross Country

Open areas- masks mandatory, social distancing (leave when your student is done competing)

Away Events (Middle School, JV and Varsity) Each district will vary and we will follow their local guidelines.
