Theme: The Amazing International Race
Incoming Grades 6-8 (Fall 2021)

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Welcome to the Raymore-Peculiar Amazing International Race Summer School Program. Our 2021 Summer School Program will offer exciting learning opportunities for all of our students with an emphasis on hands-on, engaging activities. Below you will find answers to frequently asked questions. If you have any further questions or concerns, please contact your child's school.

Who will attend: This year's in-person Summer Program is open to all students. However, if your child needs additional remediation following the regular school year, you will be notified. It is important to note, students who miss two or more days of a in-person summer school session will be unenrolled from the summer program. Students who do not log-in by day two (June 8th and July 8th) to the Launch virtual courses will be unenrolled from the summer school program.

Enrollment: Enrollment will be on a first come, first serve basis. Any enrollment forms received after May 14th will be put on a waiting list. Enrollment from the waiting list will be determined by class size and classroom space available. You will be notified regarding your child's enrollment. Dates and Times:

In-Person

Middle School in-person summer school for enrichment will be held at **Raymore Peculiar High School** Monday June 7th through Thursday, July 1st. Middle school summer school in-person remediation courses will also be held at Raymore Peculiar High School from Monday, June 7th through Thursday, July 1st. Students entering grades 6-8 will attend school from **7:25 a.m. to 2:45 p.m.**

Virtual

Middle School virtual summer school enrichment courses (first session) will be offered through Launch starting on June 7th through Wednesday, June 30th. The second session of enrichment courses will be offered though Launch starting on Wednesday, July 7th through Friday, July 30th.

How the program works: The middle school in-person summer school program for enrichment is divided into two sessions. Session 1 begins Monday, June 7, and runs 8 consecutive school days ending on Thursday, June 17. Session 2 begins on Monday, June 21, and runs until Thursday, July 1st. Students may attend one or both sessions. You will be asked to indicate your choice of sessions on the online enrollment form.

The middle school summer school program for in-person remediation begins Monday, June 7th and runs Monday-Thursday for four weeks, ending on Thursday, July 1st. If your student is being required to attend remediation courses, you will be notified regarding enrollment.

The middle school summer virtual program will offer two, four-week sessions. The first session will be offered through Launch starting on June 7th through Wednesday, June 30th. The second session will be offered though Launch starting on Wednesday, July 7th through Friday, July 30th. Students can attend one or both of these sessions.

All students should bring their end-of-school year supplies back to use during the summer program. These would include the basics such as backpack, pencils, markers, glue, scissors, and paper.

Lunch/Breakfast: Breakfast and lunch will be complimentary and served daily:

Safety Protocols: The District is currently working with Cass County Health Department to determine proper safety protocols for summer school. When those are complete, additional information will be provided. Our desire is to resume as many typical school protocols as possible. We do believe masks will be required when students and staff are not able to socially distance.

Transportation:

Morning and afternoon transportation will be provided through the district's contracted provider (Apple Bus Company, phone # 318-1900). Bus routes will be modified based on student enrollment. Students may have to board their bus at a stop that differs from their regular location. Further information will be provided.

Behavior Expectations: The behavior expectations are the same as during the regular school year. In addition, students who are not able to demonstrate appropriate behavior or are disruptive to the learning environment may be sent home and dropped from the remainder of the summer program.
