

Fall 2021 PROTOCOLS



HEALTH AND HYGIENE

- Maintain hand sanitation stations
- Frequent hand washing will be required
- Physical distancing of 3 feet or greater when possible



FACILITIES AND ROUTINES

- Limit large group assemblies
- No fountain use (students need to bring water bottles)



ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL

- Parents stay in vehicle
- Follow established school protocols
- Students report to classroom upon arrival



BUS TRANSPORTATION

- Additional cleaning and sanitation procedures
- Drivers and monitors will wear face coverings while students are loading and unloading
- Students will wear face coverings at all times



NO VISITORS

- No parents or visitors in the school building during the instructional school day



VENTILATION

- Continue to increase air filter filtration ratings
- Rooftop unit fans run full time when building is occupied
- Adjust outside air dampers to improve airflow

NOTE: Because of the current uncertainty of COVID-19, there is the potential for extended classroom, school or district closures during the school year. Please think about personal contingency planning should an extended classroom, school or district closure become necessary.



FACE COVERINGS

- Face coverings are required for all persons regardless of vaccination status in all indoor settings when consistent physical distancing is not possible
- Face coverings are not required in outdoor settings, but are highly recommended in large groups of people



CAFETERIA PROCEDURES

- Students wash hands prior to eating
- Touchless check-out system for students
- Breakfast will be consumed in the classroom
- Lunch will be consumed in the cafeteria
- Students to eat in assigned groups or areas



RECESS

- Students sanitize hands before and after recess
- Additional supervision to assist in encouraging social distance guidelines



STAY HOME WITH THESE SYMPTOMS:

- Fever or chills
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- New loss of taste or smell
- Nausea or vomiting
- Cough
- Headache
- Sore throat
- Muscle aches
- Diarrhea



ISOLATION PROTOCOL IF SYMPTOMS PRESENT AT SCHOOL:

- Face covering required
- Student isolated
- Parent picks up (no bus transportation)
